

Thinking of Getting an eReader?

Some questions to think about :

- **Do you like to read at the beach or in bright sunlight?**
Then you may want a reader with a matte finish rather than a glossy finish. Some devices have stick on protection covers that have a matte finish.
- **Do you like to read in bed while your partner is sleeping (or just in a dark setting)?**
Then you may want to get a device that has backlighting or comes with a case that you can attach a small light.
- **Do you want to be able to download magazines or newspapers as well?**
Then you may want a device from an organization that offers those features or a device that has applications that can be installed to allow for this ability.
- **What kind of devices do your friends or family have?**
Selecting devices the same as or that work similar to the device your friends or family use, they will be able to assist you more easily.
- **Do you have limited visibility?** You may want a device that has a larger screen so you can use a larger font.
- **Do you want to download library books without having to your device to a computer?**
At this time, you have to access a computer to download a library book using the various Sony, Kobo, Nook readers and the earlier Kindle readers.
- **Do you want an eReader separate from other devices or all in one?**
The next question is do you want to read books on a reader that is designed primarily for that purpose or is reading an eBook just one of many tasks you want to do with one device. That being the case, you may want to look at a tablet or smartphone.
